Dear Heifer University Applicant,

Thank you for your interest in the Heifer University for College and University Students program scheduled for October 28-31, 2010. In order to be considered for this scholarship program, complete the following application and return it no later than October 8, 2010. Notifications concerning program acceptance will be sent out the week of October 15, 2010.

This program is for college and university students who are interested in learning about Heifer's work and have the motivation to look for ways to collaborate with and support Heifer on their campus. Some pre- and post- program commitments will be expected of all participants since the program is designed to inspire and train participants for leadership roles with Heifer programs in your area. The program will be held at Heifer Ranch, one of Heifer's learning centers, located on a working farm in Perryville, Arkansas. You can learn more about Heifer Ranch at www.heifer.org/ranch.

For this particular program, participants receive a grant from Heifer International which includes all programming, shared lodging and meals. Participants are responsible for their own transportation to and from Heifer Ranch. If you plan to fly, we recommend arriving at the Little Rock Airport, approximately one hour east of Heifer Ranch. Heifer International can arrange transportation to and from the Little Rock Airport for you. If you will need transportation, please e-mail your itinerary to heiferu@heifer.org no later than October 22, 2010. For driving directions to Heifer Ranch, visit www.heifer.org/ranchdirections.

Participants will stay in a climate-controlled lodge with two people to a room. If you have a preferred roommate, please indicate on your application with whom you would like to share a room. While towels and linens are provided, guests will need to bring their own personal toiletries (shampoo, etc.) Meals are served cafeteria-style featuring many meats and vegetables produced on Heifer Ranch. The program will begin with dinner at 6:00 p.m. on Thursday, October 28 and will end with lunch on Sunday, October 31. Be sure to indicate any special dietary needs on your registration form.
